

**COLD SALAD COOK-OFF FOR A CAUSE**  
**SATURDAY, JUNE 12<sup>TH</sup> 2021 | 11:30AM – 4PM**  
**AT ROCKWELL'S HIGHWAY 7 | SPONSORED BY 6ZERO7 EVENTS**

**READ IN FULL, BEFORE YOU REGISTER** – you may register as an individual, group, business or organization (we have a goal of 16 entries, with room for 20)

**#1** – salads must be produced in a licensed kitchen

Unsure about how to access a licensed kitchen? You can work with a local restaurant or bar, reach out to a local church or soup kitchen, or perhaps your local VFW, Elks or Moose lodge. These are just some locations that may be able to offer use of a licensed kitchen.

**#2** – salads must be transported and stored in coolers, holding appropriate food handling temperatures

**#3** – salads should be made with the intention to serve cold

**#4** – each Contestant must name a local organization of choice to benefit from their cold salad entry

**#5** – an entry fee of \$30.00 is due at the time of registration, 100% of entry fees will be split between the benefiting organizations of the top three cold salads (to be judged by 30 guests pre-selected at random)

**#6** – Contestants will be required to confirm participation by picking up materials from Rockwell's Highway 7 during normal business hours the Monday thru Thursday before the event. Materials to be picked up: 30 count, 8 ounce souffle cups with lids. Make sure your cooler stays to temp and has space for containers. The 30 count is for judging only. At your own cost, you will want to decide how to sell individual servings (food grade container with lid required) and at what price. The funds you collect to be donated to the local organization you selected.

**DAY OF COOK-OFF** – failing to follow terms and conditions will lead to disqualification

Contestants must arrive to check in and setup between 10AM and 11AM, event start time for public entry is 11:30AM. Contestants are asked to stay for the full duration of the event (until 4PM). 6ZERO7 Events to provide printed surveys for judging and disposable tasting spoons so patrons may sample before purchasing.

Contestants must bring their own furnishings but space may not exceed one 10x10 canopy. Coolers, tables, chairs. Electric will not be provided.

Contestants must display the signage provided during check in, this will include details of your entry (which are gathered on your registration form).

**Top 3** cold salads, determined by judge surveying will win the Contestant an award and the benefiting organization a cash donation. Cash donations to be determined by # of entries and event sponsorship turnout.

Rockwell's Highway 7 reserves the right to remove any contestants or salad entries that have not or are not following Chenango County Health Department regulations or RH7 safety guidelines set in place.
